Age Range Supported	Ages 7-11
Capacity – number of places	There are 12 places in our Nazareth Rooms. Pupils allocated an ARP place would usually have an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHC Plan). <u>The borough's local authority specialist panels are the only agency that can allocate an ARP place.</u>
Primary Need Focus of the ARP	Complex learning needs due to cognition and learning difficulties. Pupils might have additional learning needs. Placement not suitable for pupils who have Autism Spectrum as their primary area of need, nor Behaviour as their primary area of need.
Placement Criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cognition and learning difficulties with associated SEN and student is likely to have long term SEN needs. • Pupils working within pre–Key Stage Standards at end of KS2 / below age expectations. • Pupils might have additional physical needs. • There is a strong focus on inclusion. Pupils are fully included in the wider school. Lunch and break times are fully inclusive. • Pupils follow the full primary curriculum and are taught by subject specialist with additional targeted support as required. • There is a high emphasis on developing functional basic skills. • There is a high emphasis on developing social interaction and independence. • Typical pupils at band F and above.
