| <b>Placement Criteria</b>            | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Cognition and learning difficulties with associated SEN and student is likely to have long term SEN needs.</li><li>• Pupils working within P scales at the end of KS2.</li><li>• Pupils might have additional physical needs.</li><li>• There is a strong focus on inclusion. Pupils are fully included in the wider school. Lunch and break times are fully inclusive. ARP student can also use the base at these times.</li><li>• Pupils follow the full primary curriculum and are taught by subject specialist with additional targeted support as required.</li><li>• There is a high emphasis on developing functional basic skills.</li><li>• There is a high emphasis on developing social interaction and independence.</li><li>• Typical pupils at Band F and above.</li></ul> |
