<b>Age Range Supported</b>	Ages 6-11 (Year 1 to Year 6)
<b>Capacity – number of places</b>	There are 12 places in our Nazareth Rooms.
<b>Primary Need Focus of the ARP</b>	<p>Complex learning needs due to cognition and learning difficulties.</p> <p>Pupils might have additional learning needs.</p> <p><b>Placement is not suitable for pupils who have Autism Spectrum Disorder as their primary are of need, nor Behaviour as their primary area of need.</b></p>
<b>Placement Criteria</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cognition and learning difficulties with associated SEN and student is likely to have long term SEN needs.</li> <li>• Pupils working within pre–Key Stage Standards at end of KS2 / below age expectations.</li> <li>• Pupils might have additional physical needs.</li> <li>• There is a strong focus on inclusion. Pupils are fully included in the wider school. Lunch and break times are fully inclusive. ARP student can also use the base at these times.</li> <li>• Pupils follow the full primary curriculum and are taught by subject specialist with additional targeted support as required.</li> <li>• There is a high emphasis on developing functional basic skills.</li> <li>• There is a high emphasis on developing social interaction and independence.</li> <li>• Typical pupils at Band F and above.</li> </ul>
