

<u>Updated Behaviour Policy Addendum – September 2020.</u> <u>In relation to Covid 19</u>

The aim of this addendum is to create a secure and happy school during disruption to the usual school routine caused by the Coronavirus pandemic. We wish to continue to encourage and reinforces good behaviour and the children's

As a school family, we will continue to:

well-being during this challenging time.

- 1. Listen to and co-operate with each other.
- 2. Treat everyone with politeness, kindness and respect.
- 3. Work to the best of our ability.
- 4. Move safely and calmly around school.
- 5. Respect each other's property.
- 6. Take care of our school environment.

Responsibilities of Staff:

- To continue a fair & consistent approach to behaviour management
- Create a calm, safe and positive environment for all children
- To share with children additional rules & routines

Responsibilities of Pupils to Adhere to the Following Rules:

- When entering or exiting the school premises, pupils must only enter and exit the school at designated entry and exit points, taking markings and posters into account
- Follow the 2 metre distancing when socialising, lining up, moving around the school, wherever possible
- Stay in designated classroom space
- Follow the designated corridor system around school. Walking at all times
- Remain in designated team 'bubble' at all times. Including designated play areas at break time and lunchtime
- Follow instructions on hygiene: including regular hand washing and use of hand sanitiser
- At break time and in class, there is no sharing of any personal stationery such as pencils, pens, rulers, water bottles or cups
- There is a strict rule of one boy and one girl leaving the classroom to go to the toilet and try to maintain a 2m distance from children from other bubbles
- Children must ask to go to the toilet when outside
- Under no circumstances are you to cough, sneeze, shout or spit towards anybody. Always keep a safe distance in case this happens accidentally. This is a serious breach of the behaviour policy and would result in a sanction from the Headteacher.
- Tell an adult if you are feeling unwell immediately
- Your teachers will make sure you are safe in school and will reward and sanction behaviour in line with our behaviour policy
