Dear Parent,

Your child will be working on the following curriculum during this term. Please feel free to talk to the Class teacher about any area of this curriculum.

Mathematics

In Maths this term, the children will be mostly learning multiplication and division as well as addition and subtraction. Some topics will include the following:

- Building on the 11 and 12x tables
- Mentally multiplying three numbers
- Using column addition and subtraction for both 3-digit and 4-digit numbers.
- Multiplying 2-digit and 3-digit numbers by a 1-digit number using a formal written method.
- Dividing 2-digit and 3-digit numbers by a 1-digit number using a formal written method.

In Geometry we will be looking at:

- Acute angles
- Obtuse angles
- Acute and obtuse angles in shapes
- Right angles

We ask that the children continue practicing their times tables at home in preparation for our times tables test. Additionally, please complete homework (given out Friday and handed in Tuesday) is also important in aiding the children in their understanding of these topics. If you require any help, please don't hesitate in seeing any Year 4 teacher.

Computing

In Computing, we will be focusing on Writing for different audiences and Effective Searching for the children to explore and discover alternative ways of presenting and searching. This will be used to support the Science, Topic and English curriculum.

P.E.

We are taking part in swimming lessons this term. Children will visit the local swimming pool once a week for the duration of the term.

Music

In music this term, we will listen to and appraise various songs. We will be using glockenspiels to perform a song about friendship.
