

✓ Play with play dough.



✓ Use a rolling pin to roll play dough.



✓ Roll "snakes" with play dough using palms of hands.




Roll play dough into tiny balls using only the fingertips.




- ✓ Use a spray bottle filled with water to spray plants indoors or outside.
- ✓ Add food coloring to water in a spray bottle and spray design.







 Cut a length of string or a pipe cleaner and thread with beads, pasta or cheerios.



✓ Tear paper and make a collage.






✓ Transfer each object from a bowl to a numbered cup, counting in the correct number to match and make it more interesting.



- Cut up catalogues or junk mail, especially thick paper.
- Cut play dough with plastic scissors.
- Cut plastic, disposable straws or shredded paper.






✓ Place buttons on drawn lines.



✓ Pick up and move plastic bottle caps between containers, using tongs.




✓ Squeeze and transfer water to ice cube trays.




✓ Use a hole punch to make confetti or match numerals.



✓ Transfer blocks to a muffin tin using a spatula.








Thread pipe cleaners through holes in a box.



Thread pipe cleaners through holes in a colander.



✓ Scoop pom poms from a container of water and count in the correct number into cups labelled with numbers.





✓ Place the correct number of elastic bands around sticks to match the number.




✓ Use tweezers, chopsticks and other small tools to pick up and sort small objects like pom poms or buttons.



✓ Use tape and dispensers to join models or make pictures.



Cut a slit in a tennis ball, draw a face on it and children use the ball to pick up little objects like Lego, marbles or beads.





✓ Place paper clips around card to create worms or other creatures.



✓ Chain the correct number of paper clips together to match numerals.



✓ Put letters on pegs and put them on sticks to spell words.



✓ Peg the correct number of clothes pegs to cups labelled with numbers.



✓ Use paper or ribbon to thread around wire racks.
