Instructions for creating one heart to send in:

1. Look at some interesting examples of artwork which include hearts.



- 2. Experiment with different techniques: sewing, painting, drawing...
- 3. And some different colour combinations....
- 4. Now create one heart. Take your time.
- 5. Take a photo of your heart artwork. Here are some tips for how to take a good photo:
- Good light: outside is great.

- Still object: put your heart artwork on a steady surface, or in a helper's steady hand!
- Stay steady: hold the camera or device steady.
- Centre: keep the heart in the centre of what you can see.
- Background: try to include as little background as possible.
- Ask someone at home to check your photo Does your heart have clear colours, is it in focus, and does it fill the photo?
