

Home Learning Tasks – Year 4

- **Read the story and answer the following questions.**
 - *What makes these two characters so extraordinary?*
 - *How are they similar/different to a normal father and son?*
 - *What power do they possess? Can you explain it?*
 - *Why does the boy possess the same power as his father?*
 - *Are there any other powers that they possess?*
 - *How will they use their powers?*
 - *Will they be able to lead a normal life?*
 - *Are they always in control of their powers?*
 - *Are we always in control of our powers and feelings?*
- **Perfect picture** - *What power is it that they possess? Can you draw them using their power? Could they use it in such a way as to help people?*
- **Sentence challenge** - *The picture is in black and white. Imagine that it is in colour. Can you describe the scene using the colours within it?*
- **Sick sentences** - *These sentences are 'sick' and need help to get better. Can you help?*
