English tasks:

- Watch and listen to the story *War Horse* (Episodes 4 - 6)

- Read an age appropriate book from home for 25 minutes. Write a one paragraph summary of the book detailing all that happens. Create five questions for each of the VIPER reading skills – Vocabulary, Infer, Predict, Explain, Retrieve, and Summarise.
- Create five new grammar flash cards (pick topics you found difficult). Cut a piece of A4 in half and use your CGP book to help you. Include top tips, key facts and examples.
