More challenges:

- Grab some containers of different sizes (egg cups, beakers, plastic storage boxes, pots and pans), and water (in the sink, the bath, or a bucket outside), and compare capacities of containers by filling and pouring water from one to another. Compare the containers to see which holds the most, the least, etc. Remember, a taller, thinner container does not necessarily always hold more than shorter, wider ones. Challenge: Try drawing your own scales on empty plastic bottles in non-standard units (e.g. egg cups) or standard units (e.g. 100 ml).

- Why were the friends of Jesus full of new life?
- Why do you think the officials were annoyed?
- What happened to Peter and John?

- What did they say to the council?
- How did Peter and John show their courage to the officials?
- What would you have done? Why?

Geography: Research Hawaii. Then research Samoa. What is similar about the two places and what is different? Think about:

- Where is this place located in the world?
- How big is the place?
- How many islands does it have?
- How many volcanoes does it have?
- What is its capital city? What is the capital city like?
- Other physical geography including: landscape, plants and animals
- Other human geography including: exports (goods that it sells to other countries)

Write a comparison of the two places, or you could create a table or create a poster showing the similarities and differences between Hawaii and Samoa (like we did for the Alps and the Andes).

Science: To consider how humans can reduce the effects of changes to the environment.

1. Research how the followings problems effect living things

- Droughts
- Volcano eruptions
- Water pollution
- Oil spills
- Deforestation

2. How can humans reduce the impact of these changes?

PSHE: Think about some of the real life heroes we have in our local and wider community; especially thinking about our current situation. Sketch a picture of these real-life heroes to create a poster, celebrating these wonderful people. Make sure you email us your posters!
