April 24th - 2nd Sunday of Easter

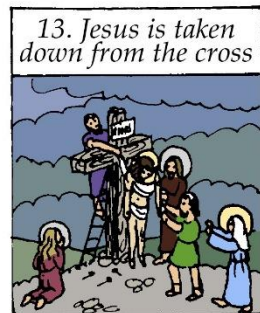
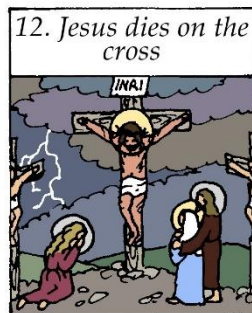
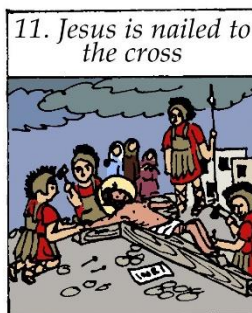
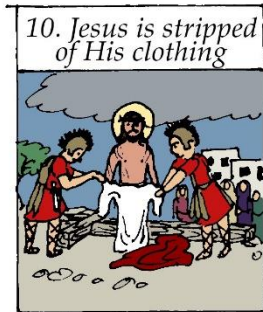
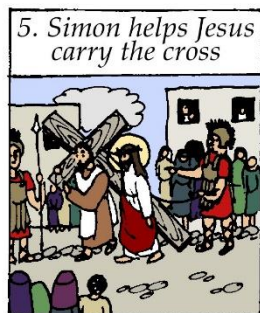
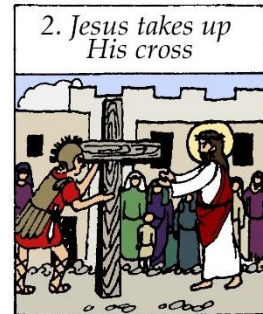
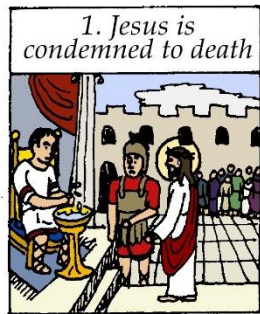
