April 18th - 3rd Sunday of Easter This Gospel tells us how Jesus appeared to his Apostles, after his resurrection.


April 25th - 4th Sunday of Easter We learn about Jesus as the Good Shepherd.

Stations of the Cross






8. Jesus speaks to the women of Jerusalem



5. Simon helps Jesus


















13. Jesus is taken
