

June 13th - 11th Sunday of Ordinary Time. In this Gospel Jesus tells us the parable of the mustard seed.

June 20th - 12th Sunday of Ordinary Time Jesus calms the storm.

June 27th - 13th Sunday of Ordinary Time Jesus raises the daughter of Jarius from the dead.
