



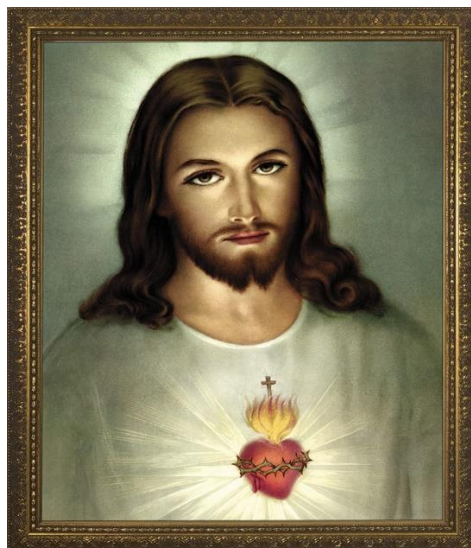

This Gospel recounts the events of the Last Supper when Jesus changed bread and wine into His Body and Blood.

June 13<sup>th</sup> - 11<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time.

In this Gospel Jesus tells us the parable of the mustard seed.

June 20<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time

Jesus calms the storm.

June 27<sup>th</sup> - 13<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time

Jesus raises the daughter of Jarius from the dead.
