



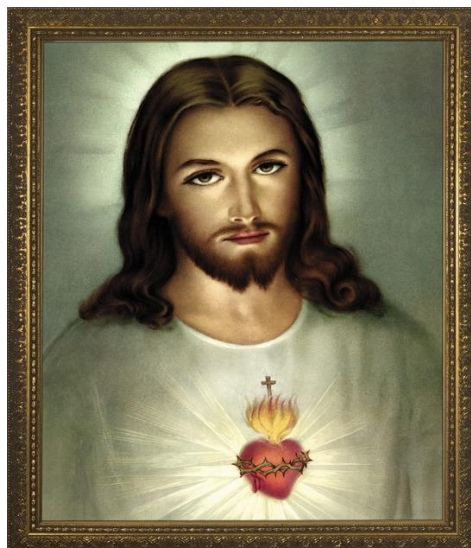

June 12<sup>th</sup> - Most Holy Trinity

Jesus tells us that the Spirit of truth will come and that everything the Father has is His.

June 19<sup>th</sup> - Corpus Christi

This Gospel relates Jesus feeding the multitude with five loaves and two fish.

June 26<sup>th</sup> - 13<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time

Jesus tells us that, "Foxes have dens and birds of the sky have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to rest his head."
