March 6th - 1st Sunday of Lent In this Gospel Jesus is led into the desert and is tempted by Satan.

March 13th - 2nd Sunday of Lent We learn about the Transfiguration of the Lord in this Gospel.

March 20th - 3rd Sunday of Lent In this Gospel Jesus tells us the story of the barren fig tree.

March 27th - 4th The parable of the Prodigal Son is recounted to us in this Gospel.
