March 1st - 1st Sunday of Lent We learn how Jesus is tempted by the devil in the desert.

March 8th - 2nd Sunday of Lent This Gospel relates the story of the Transfiguration of our Lord.

March 15th - 3rd Sunday of Lent We learn about the Samaritan woman meeting Jesus at the well.

March 22nd ⁻4th Sunday of Lent This Gospel relates the story of the blind man.

March 29th - 5th Sunday of Lent We learn in this Gospel how Jesus brings Lazarus back to life.
