This Gospel tells us the parable of the talents.

November 22nd - Solemnity of Christ the King.

Jesus tells us whatever you did for one of the least brothers of mine, you did for me.

November 29th - First Sunday of Advent.

In this Gospel, Jesus warns us to be watchful because we do not know when the Lord is coming.
