November 6th - 32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time In this Gospel Jesus tells us that "God is not God of the dead, but of the living, for to him all are live."

November 13th - 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time. Jesus tells us that "By your perseverance you will secure your lives."

November 20th - Solemnity of Christ the King. This Gospel tells us about the Jesus the Messianic Kingship of Christ Our Lord.

November 27th - 1st Sunday of Advent Jesus tells us that we must be prepared because we do not know at what hour of the day the Son of Man will come.
