The Holy Rosary**



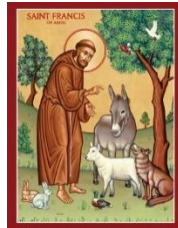
The Memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary is celebrated on 7th October.
