At short notice, Year 6 prepared the Stations of the Cross so that all children in school today could reflect on the Easter story.

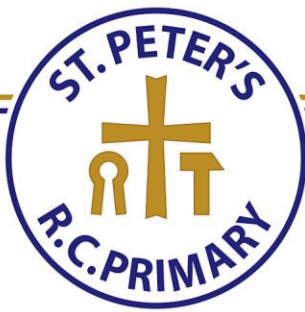
Building Work in Progress
