Dear Parents and Friends,

I hope all of our families are keeping safe and well.

Yesterday I wrote to all families with details of our reopening plans from 1st June. Please read these documents carefully.

We will be constantly reviewing and reflecting on the measures we have put into place, and adapt them as necessary. We will only extend our offer to more children when we have assessed it is safe to do so.

A reminder of the key dates

- **Monday 1st June** – School reopens for key worker children / vulnerable families who have applied for a place and been accepted
- **Week Beginning Monday 8th June** – School MAY reopen for Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 pupils only. This is likely to be a phased opening, increasing our numbers slowly throughout the week. This is subject to Government Decisions that the 5 Key Tests/Criteria have been met (this will not be decided until May 28th)
