We will be constantly reviewing and reflecting on the measures we have put into place, and adapt them as necessary. We will only extend our offer to more children when we have assessed it is safe to do so.

Thank you to all the children who have been with us in school this week! You have lifted our spirits and you have been amazing in maintaining a safe distance from each other. The chatter, the beaming smiles, the positivity of all staff and the praise and thanks from you our parents has melted away the stresses and anxieties of the past few months.

I would like to take this opportunity to say a huge thank you to my staff who have been united as a team in rising to the challenges that we have faced. Their resilience and love for the children mean that we have been able to implement many new systems, safety measures, and risk assessments, whilst still maintaining a sense of fun and a love of learning.

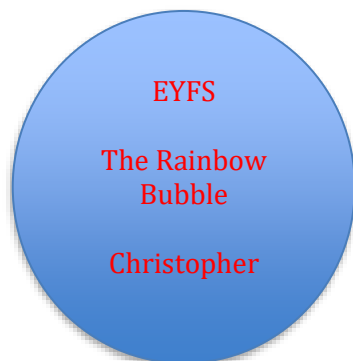
