Dear Parents and Friends,

Yesterday the Government released the guidance on how to plan for the full re-opening of schools in September. I am delighted that in September we will be able to welcome all children back to school. Over the next week or so I will be meeting with Governors and staff to plan how we will put this into practice for our school community.

For the rest of this term with the current restrictions in place, the school is at full capacity. Unfortunately, this means we will not be able to facilitate a further zoom meeting with class teachers as all staff are all busy working in class with the children here in school.

Our focus is now on planning for all children in September and I will write to you next week with details of who your child's teacher will be in September. There will be links to videos and letters from the new teachers sent home.


