

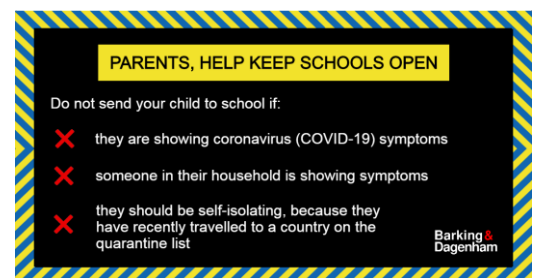

COVID-19 Communications

We have received the following from the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham:



Keep our Community Safe

Thank you for supporting the safety measures St. Peter's have in place. We must all continue to work together to stop the spread of coronavirus, keep each other safe and avoid another lockdown.

Visiting the School Site

When dropping your child off, or waiting to pick them up, you must:

- Wear a face mask (unless you are exempt from wearing one)
- Stay at least 2 metres away from others

Self-isolation

Do not send your child to school if:

- They are showing [coronavirus \(COVID-19\) symptoms](#)
- Someone in their household is showing symptoms

Please also self-isolate yourself and your family for the advised amount of time if you have just returned from a country on the Government's quarantine list.

Tests

[Arrange a test](#) only if you or your child develops symptoms and please inform us of the results

Coronavirus Testing

We have a new school out of hour's office telephone number for parents to use if you need to report that you or your child has tested positive for Coronavirus. You can use this number in the evenings or at weekends: **07368 129683**.

First Holy Communion

This weekend, some of our children will be making their First Holy Communion. Please keep them and their families in your prayers.

Attendance

Our whole school attendance since we came back in September is 96.6% which is amazing considering the current situation. So well done and thank you to all our families!

Bike and Scooter Safety

Some children are still riding their bikes and scooters on the school premises. This could become a safety hazard. Please make sure your child dismounts at the school gate on the way to school. On the way home please ensure they do not get back on their bike or scooter until they have passed through the school gate. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding in this matter.

Breakfast Club and After School Club

We still have spaces in both clubs. If you are interested, registration forms can be picked up from the office, downloaded from the website or you should have received them by email yesterday. Both clubs are COVID-19 safe and your child will remain in their year group bubble. Breakfast Club costs £2.50 per session and After School Club costs £9 per session, all payable on your child/children's Parent Pay account.
