### **Reception 2021**

If you have a child born between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2016 and 31<sup>st</sup> August 2017, they will be eligible to start full time school in September 2021. The admissions process will begin on 1<sup>st</sup> November 2020 and will close on 15<sup>th</sup> January 2021. Information packs will be available from the school office from 2<sup>nd</sup> November.

### **Attendance**

Our whole school attendance since we came back in September was 96.6% which was amazing considering the current situation. For October, we have improved and our attendance is 97.66%, so well done and thank you to all our families!

### **Bike and Scooter Safety**
