The areas we will be covering are:

- Where is Africa?
- What animals live in Africa?
- What is special about Africa?
- Finding out about African artists and exploring how to recreate pictures and models.

• Exploring African music- Call and response songs and drumming. Some topic work and activities:

- Make a diary about your favourite animals you saw on Safari.
- Research Africa then draw and label pictures or write sentences about interesting facts.
- Discuss any African traditions you may celebrate and share pictures or photographs.

- African style art pieces: Look at the work of artist Yinka Shonibare Try to create your own Fabric design!
- Have a go at the Zootime module or get out your pots and pans and have a go at drumming along to the Djembe lessons assigned by logging into your Charanga Yumi account.
- Get out some pots and pans to use as drums and copy each other's rhythms and patterns. Then play and sing along to this call and response song. <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=kGDkYuPCaeO</u>

- Describing features of animals- play with any toy animals at home- talk together about what they look like Can the children describe them?
- Use a selection of toy animals and see if you find different ways to sort them e.g. animals that live in water/ animals that live on sand

• Animals that live in warm places/ animals that live in cold places.
