In our school we aim to provide children with History lessons that will engage and develop their skills as young historians.

Each term we will introduce children to a new topic in History that they will be able to explore. During these lessons children will build upon their enquiry skills required to ask perceptive questions; the analysis skills needed to think critically and evaluate source-based evidence; and the problem-solving skills necessary for them to build their own judgements on past events and people.

As the children continue their journey beyond their time at St Peter's, we want our them to have a secure knowledge of past events and people, as well as an appreciation for the ever-evolving nature of history. They will be able to make comparisons across different eras.
