Instructions Checklist

Title which shows what the text is about. It may begin "How to"	Adverbs for how the actions should be done.
Sub-headings to break the text into clear sections.	Chronological order and Adverbs of Time.
An opening sentence which encourages the reader to have a go.	Technical vocabulary which is specific to the task.
A clear list of equipment or ingredients needed.	Diagrams or illustrations with labels.
Simple steps for each action in the method.	Formal, impersonal tone.
Imperative (bossy) verbs telling the reader what to do.	Closing statement which shows or describes what the reader has achieved.
Bullet points or numbers for each step.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation has already been explained to you in the previous lesson. **Read it again** and discuss the following questions (you may discuss these with an adult or carer).

SOME KEY QUESTIONS

Why do you think this Sacrament is called 'Reconciliation'?

Why is Reconciliation important for everyone?

What kind of things do you think the priest might say to the penitent? How do you think the person feels when they hear the words of forgiveness and absolution?

What kind of things might a person do to make up for their sins?

ACTIVITY

Write out these sentences in the correct order.

- 1. The person leaves the priest and prays and thanks God for forgiving them and completes the penance the priest has asked them to do.
- 2. The penitent (person confessing his/her sins), takes time to examine their conscience (life). This means to think about the times they have not followed Jesus' way of love and kindness.
- 3. The priest says the words of forgiveness and absolution.
- 4. The priest welcomes the penitent, and they both make the Sign of the Cross.
- 5. The person then prays an act of sorrow, which includes the promise to try not to do the same again.

- 6. The priest talks kindly to them and encourages them to do or say something to make up for what they have done wrong. This is called a penance.
- 7. The penitent confesses (tells the priest his/her sins).
