Your child will be working on the following curriculum during this half-term. Please feel free to email <u>yearthree@st-peter.bardaglea.org.uk</u> if you have any queries.

Mathematics In Maths we will revise Year 2 topics including place value, addition and subtraction. We will also revise key skills using practical activities where possible. Children will get an opportunity to review skills they may have forgotten in our daily Maths On Track sessions. We will then be moving onto geometry where we will be exploring the properties of 2D and 3D shapes. In addition to this, the children will be learning and applying new mathematical concepts and terminology related to shape. Children may be set challenges to aid their progression at their own pace. The curriculum will include practical, real life problems for them to solve. Please practice times tables at home using Times Table Rock Stars. In the coming term, the children will learn about E-safety. This encompasses lots of different strategies to keep themselves safe online and out of harm's way. We will also explore the topics 'Touch typing' and 'Emails'.		English We will start the year with reading 'The Tin Forest'. A tale of transformation. An old man lives in a grey and forsaken place 'that looked out on other people's rubbish and bad weather'. He dreams of a wild and colourful place and uses the resources around him in such a creative way that change comes about and a natural forest becomes entwined with one of metal. We will use this book to help make predictions, compose poetry, write diary entries and letters. In our SpAG sessions, we will be focusing on: • Exclamation marks • Full stops and capital letters • Full stops and capital letters	
MFL (French) We will be introducing the children to the French language and some basic greetings and keywords. The children will start to become more familiar with the culture and customs of France and other speaking countries.		History In History we will be looking at Stone Age people through to the Iron Age. Children will be expected to look at artefacts and discover how our ancestors lived through an archeological approach. We will also be learning about special topics about historical days, such a Remembrance Day.
