# PE

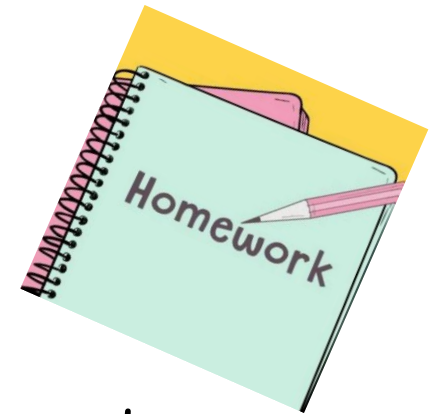


- Monday and Tuesday for 3H. Tuesday and Thursday for 3W.

- Practise times tables.
- Spellings will be given out on Friday and do not need to be returned to school.
- A Spelling Test will take place each week. Please help your child to prepare.



# Reading



- Parents or older siblings (15+) are able to sign your child's reading record- not the child.
- Please read with your child as much as possible, and sign their reading record. You may make a comment if you wish. Our expectation is that children will have their book signed at least four times a week.
- All children should bring their reading book and reading record to school every day. Please make sure that they take care of these books.



# Uniform

- Please ensure your child has the correct uniform and that it is labelled with your child's name and class. Please do not forget to label coats, jumpers and cardigans.
- Summer uniform can be worn until October half term.
- This includes the correct school bag with the school logo.



# Fruit

- No fruit is provided for children in the juniors.
- If you would like to, you can provide your child with one piece of fruit, that they can eat at play time.



# Packed Lunch
