RE:

After Moses led the Israelites out of Egypt, he shared a list of 10 rules with them to help live peacefully and happily as one community. These are the 10 commandments.

God said 'I am the Lord your God who brought you out of Egypt, where you were slaves.

1. Worship no god but me. Do not make for yourselves images of anything in heaven or on earth or in the water under the earth. Do not bow down to any idol or worship it, because I am the Lord your God
2. Do not use my name for evil purposes.
3. Observe the Sabbath and keep it holy. You have six days in which to do your work, but the seventh day is a day of rest dedicated to me. On that day no one is to work –neither you, your children, your slaves, your animals, nor the foreigners who live in your country. In six days I, the Lord, made the earth, the sky, the seas, and everything in them, but on the seventh day I rested. That is why I, the Lord, blessed the Sabbath and made it holy.
4. Respect your father and your mother, so that you may live a long time in the land that I am giving you.
5. Do not kill.
6. Do not be unfaithful.
7. Do not steal.
8. Do not lie against your neighbour.
9. Do not be greedy and want what other people own.
10. Do not take another's husband or wife. '

Based on Exodus 20 1-17

Which of the 10 commandments do you think are the most important? Choose 3 and create a poster about them. This could include drawings of how others can follow them.

Topic (History/Geography): *Locate South Africa on a map and find 5 facts about it.*

Science: *Choose 3 different materials and list some of their properties/adjectives to describe them (e.g. Wood – Hard, solid, durable, insulator (cannot carry heat), burns)*

PSHE: Continue creating a Wellbeing Journal and use it every day throughout the week. It could include:

1. Date / Day of the Week
2. Top 5 Goals for the day
3. 3 things you are grateful for
4. 1 positive change you would like to bring to the world
