

Home Learning Tasks – Year 6

Week beginning: 30/3/19

English tasks:

- Think about the key words associated with Easter and create a spider diagram plan for an Easter poem. This plan needs to be detailed enough for five stanzas of four verses.
- Create your Easter poem – this should be five stanzas of four verses. Get all of the common themes of Easter in the poem using lots of language based around our faith.
- Read an age appropriate book from home for 30 minutes. Write a character description of the main character or a key character in the book.
- Read an age appropriate book from home for 25 minutes. Write a one paragraph prediction of what you think will happen next in the poem. Create five questions for each of the VIPER reading skills – Vocabulary, Infer, Predict, Explain, Retrieve, Summarise.
- Create five grammar flash cards. Cut a piece of A4 in half and then create a revision poster on an element of grammar from your CGP book. Include top tips, key facts and examples.

Maths Tasks:

- Create 30 different arithmetic questions based on Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication, Division and Fractions. Answer these questions and mark them.
- In your CGP Maths revision book, find a topic you want to practise. Alter the questions to create a set of questions for you to answer and then mark.
- Go onto Mathletics and complete five reasoning tasks based around: All Four Operations, Ratio + Proportion and Fractions.
- Go onto BBC bitesize and revise a topic of your choosing. Complete the tasks at the bottom of the page and play the learning games provided.
- Create five Maths flash cards. Cut a piece of A4 in half and then create a revision poster on an element of Maths from your CGP book. Include top tips, key facts and examples.

'Other' Tasks:

RE: Write a Newspaper article about Jesus being crucified, as if it had happened the day before. Create a headline, a 5 W's paragraph, a quotes paragraph and a reorientation paragraph.

History: Research what life was like in Victorian workhouses. Create four subheadings and write information below them about what it was like to work in a Victorian workhouse.

Science: Look at the effect that mould and germs have on out of date food. Look at images on the internet and write a paragraph detailing how long it takes food to grow mould and rot.

PSHE: Dealing with pressure. Children to create a top tips poster based on helping people deal with pressure and how they can be themselves again.

Art: Having researched Victorian warehouses, use your knowledge (and images) to help you draw and colour/paint a Victorian warehouse.

DT: Design and create your own cobbled Victorian street! Look at the types of houses Victorian people lived in and design a street. Once this is designed, use cardboard or something similar to create the houses.

PE: Tune in at 9am every day for Joe Wicks' daily P.E. lesson. Do this later in the day if you can't make it at 9am. Also, go onto Youtube and search 'Cosmic Kids Yoga.' Take part in the Yoga Class and then do a cool down for 10 minutes afterwards.
