# <u>Home Learning Tasks – Year 6</u>

# English tasks:

- Write a diary entry summarising the events from the day. Think about your feelings and emotions. Remember to make sure the diary entry has an informal tone.
- Practise the Year 5/ 6 Common Exception Words, then choose 10 of these words. Write a synonym, antonym, the meaning and an example of how to use the word in a sentence.
- Homophones are two words that sound alike but have different meanings and spellings. "there", "their", and "they're" is a classic example of a set of Homophones. Create a list of homophones. Use a dictionary to find as many homophones are you can!
- Read a chapter from your home reading book or a book you may have borrowed from the library. Create a list of questions to interview the main character. Test out the questions by answering in role as the character. Think about the traits of the character and how this will influence the answers
- Put yourself in your Mum's or another family member's shoes. Write a poem about how they might be feeling with what is happening in the world currently? Share this poem on Purplemash via the Year 6 Blog.

# 'Other' Tasks:

*RE:* Talk about the times you might have been in a situation when you saw something happen which was unusual, strange or even wrong and you knew you needed to tell someone. You were unsure for a number of reasons. Maybe you thought people would laugh at you, not believe you, or you might get into trouble. Create a poster about why we should have courage to be a witness.

# Geography: Why should you visit Mexico?

*Create a leaflet about Mexico include information about the location, landmarks, traditional food and climate. Persuade your reader to visit. You could include illustrations.* 

Science: Write down a list of what you know and what you want to know about Electricity. Research online what a circuit is and how this helps to create electricity. List all of the objects that you need to make a circuit and draw a diagram to show how these link together to turn a lightbulb on. Write a paragraph underneath this explaining what you did and how electricity was created.

**PSHE:** Think about how lots of children will be feeling about not being able to see their friends face to face for a prolonged period of time. Write a paragraph explaining what you have learned about friendship and how friendship can take different forms. Explore and explain how you have kept your friendships strong through using phones, purple mash and so on.

Art: Research how Mexicans used animals in their artwork and what forms of art they used to portray animals. Create a piece of Mexican artwork based on animal of your choice and decorate this in a Mexican tone and style.

**DT:** Create a healthy fruit salad. Talk to your parents about the different food groups and their importance. Think about what we learnt early on in the school year.
