Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to our Autumn 2 term! We're diving into a fun-filled half term packed with creativity, exploration, and learning. Here's a snapshot of what your child will be discovering and enjoying in the coming weeks as a mixed class.

English – Supertato Adventures!

We'll be exploring the exciting world of *Supertato*! Children will enjoy reading and writing their own imaginative narratives inspired by this superhero vegetable. We'll also be learning how to write clear and fun instructions – perfect for helping Supertato save the day!

Maths

Children will continue building their confidence with:

- **Place Value**
- **Addition and Subtraction**
- **Shape (Geometry)**

We'll be using practical activities and games to make maths meaningful and enjoyable.

Science - Outdoor Learning

This term we will be focusing on planting bulbs ready for spring, looking at micro-habitats, and touching on materials around us.

Geography – Our Street & Local Fieldwork

We'll be getting to know our local area through fieldwork and map skills. Children will explore what makes our street special and how we can observe and record features of our environment.

Art – Drawing Skills

This term we'll be focusing on drawing. Children will experiment with lines, shapes, and textures to create expressive artwork inspired by their surroundings and stories.

PSHE – What is Bullying?

We'll be discussing kindness, respect, and how to recognise and respond to bullying. Our aim is to help children feel safe, confident, and empowered to speak up.

Computing – Creating Pictures & Online Safety

Children will use technology to create digital art and learn about staying safe online. We'll explore how to use devices responsibly and creatively.

Music – Exploring Pulse and Rhythm

Through singing, clapping, and playing instruments, children will explore rhythmic patterns and learn how music can express feelings and tell stories.

PE – Dance & Movement

Inspired by *Supertato* and explorers, children will develop their coordination and creativity through dance. We'll also continue working on fundamental movement skills.

RE – Celebrations and Christmas

We'll be learning about the story of Jesus' birth. Children will reflect on why Christmas is such good news and how different cultures celebrate.
