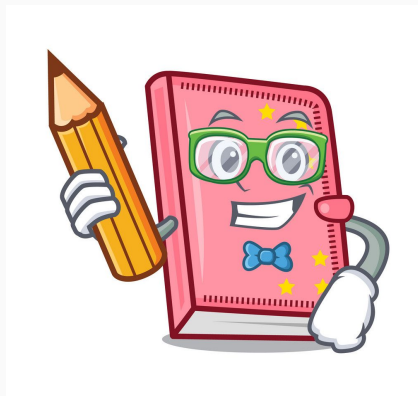

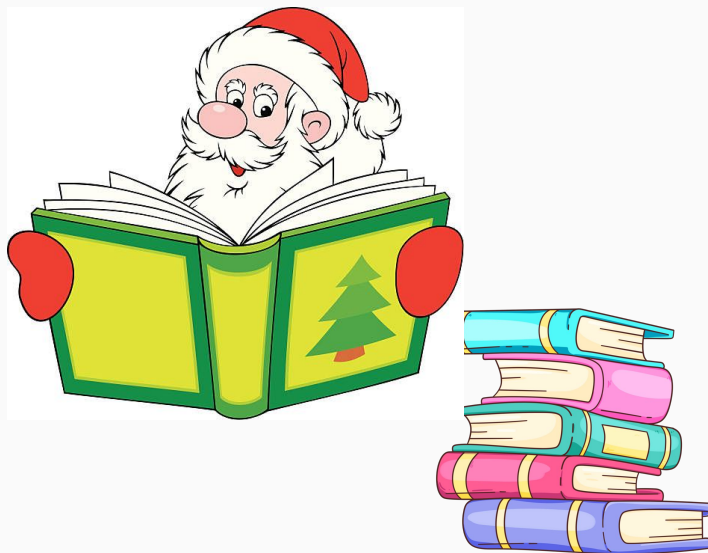


Free Santa Visit!

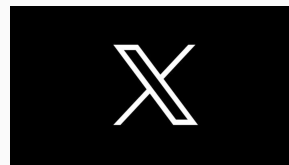
