SCRATCH CODE CLUB - Code Club for 8 - 11 year old children will return at Blackburn Library on Saturday mornings between 10.30 am and 12 pm. The club will run a little differently this time, so there will be a series of four, weekly sessions starting on 10th May and finishing on 31st May. The club is aimed at complete beginners, starting with a very basic exercise on Scratch and gradually building on skills learned week by week. To gain maximum benefit from the programme we encourage children to sign up to the full four weeks of the course rather than dipping in and out.
