## **School Day from September 21**

Subject to the Covid restrictions in place in September, the school day will be as follows:

# Start of the School Day

- Arrive between 8.30am-8.45am; official start of the day will be 8.40am and they will be late if they arrive after 8.45am
- The green gate will be opened at 8.30am and closed at 8.45am.
- Years 4, 5 and 6 will enter through the front doors.
- Years 1, 2, and 3 will enter through the green gates and go directly to their classroom.
- EYFS will enter via the blue door. Staff will greet them there.
- Children will enter all classrooms on the courtyard directly.
- No parents will enter the courtyard.

#### **End of the School Day**

EYFS will leave at 3pm through the blue door.

- The green gate will open at 3pm.
- Year 4 will leave through the back doors at 3pm,sitting on the performance steps to wait for their parents.
- Year 5 will leave through the front doors at 3pm.
- Year 6 will leave through the front doors at 3.05pm.
- All other classes will leave via their classroom doors at 3.05pm. Parents will enter the courtyard to collect their children from the classroom door.
