Allergies

There are a number of children across the school with severe nut allergies that require an epipen if they come into contact with nuts. For some of these children the allergy is airborne and they do not need to touch a nut to have a reaction. Please do not send your child to school with nuts or sandwiches with spreads that contain nuts. Thank you so much for your cooperation.

<u>Covid</u>

The rules have changed since the end of the summer term. These are the new rules:

- If your child has symptoms they need to isolate for 10 days or until they have a negative PCR test. Brothers and sisters can still attend school.
- IF your child has a positive test please inform the school office on 01254 698447 as soon as possible.
- If someone has symptoms, they need a PCR test not a lateral flow test as they are more accurate.
- The school will let you know if your child has been in close contact with a positive case. In Blackburn it is recommended that a close contact has a PCR test. There is no need for your child to be isolated unless they develop symptoms or get a positive PCR test.
- Under no circumstances should anyone who has tested positive enter the school premise until they have been isolated for the 10 days.
- Remote education will still be provided for children in isolation as long as they are well and not ill.

Traffic Outside School

The traffic outside our school has increased substantially now that we are all arriving at school at the same time. Please do not park on the yellow zig zag lines or drop your children off in the middle of the road. Both are dangerous for your child or for other children. Please park safely away from the zig zags and walk your child to school.
