Road Safety



There was nearly a serious accident near school recently. Please be careful when dropping your children off at school and do not park in the road to let them out. Please remember that the speed limit on the roads around school is 20 mph

Earrings

Please be aware that hooped earrings are **not** to be worn in school for safety reasons. A small stud can be worn in each ear. Earrings should not be worn for P.E. Children will be asked to remove them. If they are unable to do this they will not be allowed to take part in the P.E. lesson. Please teach your child how to take them out by themselves or alternatively leave them out on P.E. days if they are too young.

Please do not send your children into school with large rucksacks as they are too big to fit into the cloakroom areas, which is causing trip hazards. Children just need to bring their book bags and lunch bags, if bringing a packed lunch.

Stay and Play




Our stay and play sessions have started again. Everyone is welcome to come along every Tuesday during term time from 2 to 3pm.
