Incredible Years course for parents

The Incredible Years programme was developed by Carolyn Webster-Stratton, a clinical Psychologist, in 1997. It is designed to be a community based programme to help parents of children with ADHD, conduct problems and promote emotional and social development, emotional regulation, and improve academic success.

It aims to give you new strategies as well as building on the ones you are already using to make them more effective in your home. In turn you should see an increase in positive behaviours and a reduction in behaviours you find challenging, helping you feel more confident and reducing household stress.

This Programme will run for 2 hours a week at St Silas school for over a period of 12 weeks. In completion all participants will receive a certificate .

Stay and Play




Our stay and play sessions have started again. Everyone is welcome to come along every Tuesday during term time from 2 to 3pm.
