### Accident Forms

A new system has been introduced for recording accidents in school. It is called Medical Tracker. If your child has an accident in school it will be recorded on this tracker and you will receive an email informing you of the details. We will still ring parents for accidents that may involve your child needing further treatment or if we are concerned.
