Feedback

Your child will be expected to engage in the live lesson. Their microphone should be turned off unless asked by a teacher during the lesson. They will be asked to contribute their thoughts, ideas and suggestions via the chat box during the live lesson.

Each live lesson will be followed up with an activity that will be monitored and marked by Year 3 teachers. Specific feedback will be provided on each piece of learning and where a question has been asked by the teacher. It will then be expected that your child engages in this two way dialogue.

Assessment

Questioning will be used during lessons and the chat box monitored by teachers during the live lesson. YOur child may be invited to attend an extra session or asked to stay on at the end of the lesson for extra support.

Work will be marked and returned on a daily basis providing assessment information for your child. On some occasions your child may be asked to self assess their own learning as they would do in class. This will be followed by the class teachers.

Summative assessment will take place at the end of topics using our Lancashire English Planning Model, Power Maths and the white rose scheme and end of topic long writes for the foundation subjects (RE, History & Geography).
