Free School Meals

During the half term holiday and the lockdown, children in receipt of free school meals received a voucher for food. These are children who have applied for free school meals and receive them because their parents receive certain benefits.

Parents of children in Reception and Key Stage 1 who receive universal free school meals can still apply for free school meals if they meet the criteria. It is worth doing this even though your child receives universal free school meals as the school receives pupil premium money for each free school meal child that can be used to help your child and others. It would also mean that in any future voucher/food box scheme in a lockdown you would receive a voucher/foodbox.

This is the information from the government website:



Your child may be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

Children who get paid these benefits directly, instead of through a parent or guardian, can also get free school meals.

Your child may also get free school meals if you get any of these benefits and your child is both:

- younger than the <u>compulsory age for starting school</u>
- in full-time education

If your child is eligible for free school meals, they'll remain eligible until they finish the phase of schooling (primary or secondary) they're in on 31 March 2022.

Infant free school meals in England

Your child will be able to get free school meals if they're in a government-funded school and in:

- reception class
- year 1
- year 2

Tell your local authority if you also get any of the qualifying benefits. Your child's school can get extra funding if you do.
