

English



As writers, the children will compose writing linked to key texts using the 'Read to Write' programme.

Y1 – **Old Bear By Jane Hissey**

Y2 – **A River by Marc Martin** (plus other supporting texts)

Pupils will be looking at the structure of a sentence including punctuation, tense and grammar.

Children take part in daily phonics/spelling activities, following the Sounds-Write programme to develop their segmenting and blending to read and spell.

Year 1 readers will continue to develop and apply their phonics skills, to read by blending both familiar and unfamiliar words.

Year 2 readers will practise retrieving answers from a text. They will also think like a detective, to infer meaning from what they have read, and to understand how a character is feeling from their actions.

Maths- As mathematicians, children in Year 1 will develop their number work, with a focus on place value within 10 and addition and subtraction within 10. Children will practise counting in 2's, 5's and 10's. Children in Year 2 will continue to develop their number work with a focus on place value within 100 and start to add and subtract. Children will practise counting in 2's, 3's, 5's and 10's.

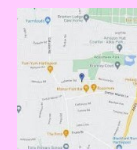


Religious Education

Across the term the children will look at the topics 'Families' and 'Signs and Symbols' which will include discussing our own baptisms and retelling significant stories from the Bible.



Geography As Geographers the children will be finding out about our local area, including a walk to investigate! We will develop simple map skills and discuss human and physical features.



Science

As Scientists the children will work scientifically while they learn about plants in their local environment. Including deciduous and evergreen trees, how plants change with the seasons and what plants need to be able to grow.

Music – Children will learn about musical vocabulary such as pulse and tempo and explore this using an 'under the sea' theme.
