Lower Key Stage 2	- Mould, carve and cut clay or other soft materials using appropriate tools.  - Build texture and shape using collage to create relief.  - Build 3-dimensional shapes from 2-dimensional materials (e.g. papier mâché).  - Use a range of techniques to attach and fix shapes together.  - Use collage (e.g. mosaic) to create images, patterns and backgrounds.
