

St. Teresa's Catholic Primary School Remote Learning 5 Phase Provision

Phase One

This covers an initial short absence (3/4 days) whilst awaiting the outcome of a COVID test (parent or sibling or other close contact). A work pack will be provided, that is aligned to the year group curriculum, with activities/tasks that provide opportunities for pre-learning/consolidation. Contact school to make us aware that a pack is needed.



Phase Three

This covers any period where a school 'bubble' is self-isolating (10 days), due to a confirmed case. Work will be provided, directly aligned to the year group curriculum, via online platforms such as Teams for key stage one and two children or See-Saw for early years children. Key stage one children will also be provided with curriculum aligned packs. Teachers will also offer email support.

Phase Two

This covers any period where a child is required to self-isolate (up to 10 days) due to having been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, tested positive themselves or has been contacted by NHS Track & Trace. Work will be provided, directly aligned to what is being taught in class. This will be prepared by the class teacher. Contact school to make us aware that a pack is needed. Teachers will also offer email support or support via our online platform.

Phase Five

This phase covers children who are shielding due to being clinically medically vulnerable or a family member who is clinically medical vulnerable. Class teachers will liaise with families directly to produce a bespoke package of support based around need.

Phase Four

This covers any period where the whole school is in lockdown. Work and live lessons will be provided, directly aligned to the year group curriculum, via online platforms for key stage one and two and EYFS. Work packs containing printed daily structured activities will be provided for key stage one children. Printed work packs will also be available for early years children. Work packs to supplement on-line learning with printed materials, exercise books, stationery packs and reading books will also be available. These packs will be refreshed fortnightly as needed in the required year groups. Teachers will also offer email support.
