Please ensure that children are collected promptly when school finishes at 3.10pm daily. However, if it becomes a regular occurrence that parents/carers are late collecting their children, then in line with our Uncollected Child Policy, parents will be charged.

Please bear in mind that staff have their own children to collect, and we cannot safeguard children effectively should they be collected late on a regular basis, as staff have finished for the day and leave the premises. In addition to this, children cannot wait in school if their sibling is in afterschool club, they must be collected at the end of the school day.
