# <u>Year 5 Curriculum Newsletter – Spring 2 – Space</u>

#### RE

We will look at completing our Memorial Sacrifice unit learning about the Eucharist.

We will also learn about Sacrifice during the season of Lent. Lent is a time for aligning with the sacrifice made by Jesus. We will also act, pray and give choosing a charity to support.

#### **English**

We are reading the book 'Comic' by Frank Cottrell-Boyce and writing our own space adventure for a new character. We will also be creating an information text and booklet using different text types.

We will also learn about Haiku poems and write our own space one.

#### Maths

We will start by looking at geometry and drawing angles using protractors. We will also be looking at negative numbers. We will also learn to plot points and use lots of different measures.

#### Science

This half term we will be describing the movement of the earth and other planets. Describing the movement of the moon. Understanding the planets are spherical.

We will also be looking at the earth's rotation to understand night and day.

#### **PSHE**

We will learn about money and living in the wider world. We will consider how people make decisions about spending and saving money and how we can decide how to pay for things such as current accounts, savings, and credit.

### **Art and Design**

This half term we will be drawing, using our sketch books to record our work. We will be using our Space theme to draw planets and their moons, focussing on scale, tone, shading, texture, pattern and shape. We will choose materials for the type of drawing we want to produce.

## <u>Music</u>

We will improvise and compose our own melody considering the use of chords and respond to a beat.

We will have tennis coaches in school and complete our Bikeability bike safety training.

# **Computing**

We will be planning a multi-scene animation including characters. We will look as editing, including title screens and then evaluate our finished work.
