



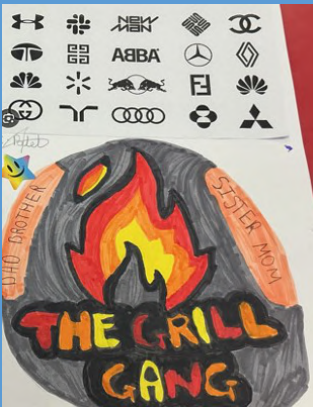

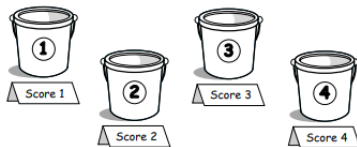
Problem Solving Time!

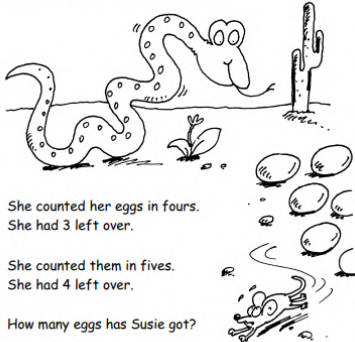


Well done to our key stage one children for displaying their amazing work and showing off their maths skills in the upper key stage two corridor. Lots of reasons to love maths!
